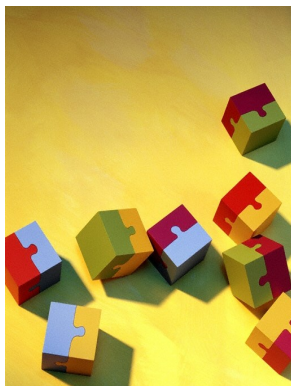

WHAT IS FAMILIES IN TRANSITION?

One out of every two marriages today ends in divorce and many divorcing families include children. Parents who are getting a divorce are frequently worried about the effect the divorce will have on their children. During this difficult period, parents may be preoccupied with their own problems, but continue to be the most important people in their children's lives.



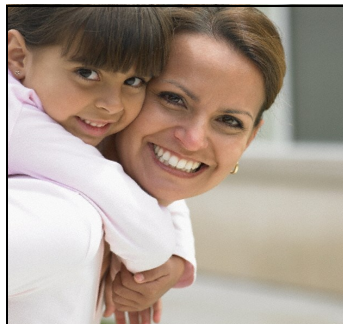
Children will do best if they know that their mother and father will still be their parents and remain involved with them even though the marriage is ending and the parents won't live together. Research shows that children do best when parents can cooperate on behalf of the child.

Why do I have to go?

The Families in Transition class is a court-ordered session designed to help families who are arranging new parenting schedules due to going through divorce, dissolution, separation or any change of custody.

What can I expect?

- Insight into how divorce, separation or a change of custody affects children.
- Ways to keep your children from being placed in the middle of parental conflict.
- Tips for building good communication skills for dealing with the other parent (or with an absent parent).
- Resources for assisting your children and yourselves through changes.
- A receipt and certificate of completion that can be presented to the court.
- The class fee is \$20 and can be paid by cash only at sign-in.
